The light of the Lord's glory shines out and draws people from all over the world: they come to worship and to praise the Lord.

Second Reading Ephesians 3:2-3. 5-6

The writer tells how the non-Jewish nations now share in the same inheritance and promise as the chosen people, through Christ Jesus.

Gospel Matthew 2:1-12 - The magi, who represent the Gentile nations, come to Jerusalem as they search for the recently born king of the Jews; they are sent on to Bethlehem, the city of King David.
