**Introduction** Lent often grabs more of our intention than Eastertide. The path to the cross seems more human than the path from the cross to the ascension, but the path that we walk is through the cross, and from the cross to heaven with the risen Christ.

**First Reading** Acts 2:14. 22-33 - The humanity of Christ was raised to fulfil the deepest longings of Israel.

Second Reading 1 Peter 1:17-21

Only the gifts of God are truly free, but the redemption is also the gift of a human being. This is why it was fitting that the Lord should pay a price for that redemption.

**Gospel** Luke 24:13-35

The Church is a conversation, as we share our faith. Sometimes we fail to allow the Lord into that conversation.
